**Adjectives on Feelings**

<b>'-ed' adjectives</b>	<p>Adjectives that end in '-ed' are used to describe how <u>people</u> feel.</p> <p>e.g.</p> <p>a. I am <u>excited</u> about the summer camp.</p> <p>b. I feel <u>relaxed</u> swimming in the sea.</p>	
<b>'-ing' adjectives</b>	<p>Adjectives that end in '-ing' are used to describe <u>things</u> and <u>situations</u>.</p> <p>e.g.</p> <p>a. The summer camp is very <u>exciting</u>.</p> <p>b. Swimming in the sea is <u>relaxing</u>.</p>

● A reminder of the different ways to pronounce words ending in ‘ed’.

The pronunciation of words ending in ED depends on the final consonant (sound). There are three ways to pronounce ED:

/ɪd/	/t/	/d/
T wanted D needed	P helped K looked SH washed CH watched GH laughed TH breathed SS kissed C danced X fixed	L called N cleaned R offered G damaged V loved S used W followed Y enjoyed Z amazed
<p><b>Voiced Sound</b> = uses the vocal cords and they produce a vibration or humming sound in the throat. <i>(Touch your throat to feel it)</i></p>	<b>VOICELESS</b>	<b>VOICED</b>
