Future Tense: 'Will'


We use '*will + base form of the verb*' when:

- a. we decide to do something, but you **are not sure** about the result of it.

e.g., I think they *will agree* to our plan.

- b. we decide to do something **on the spot**.

e.g., We have not got any juice left. I *will go* to the corner shop and get some.



- c. we **guess** what will happen.

e.g. She is working very hard. She *will come* in first in the exam.
