English Usage – Analogy

An analogy is the process of transferring information from a particular subject to another particular subject. Analogies can include a wide variety of associations between synonyms and antonyms, groupings, characteristics, jobs, animals, and transportation, amongst others.

Examples of analogies include:

Synonyms, antonyms

'delighted' is to 'happy' as 'miserable' is to 'sad' (*synonyms*)
'on' is to 'off' as 'right' is to 'wrong' (*antonyms*)

Groupings

'tuna' is to 'fish' as 'mosquito' is to 'insect'

Characteristics

'ice' is to 'cold' as 'sun' is to 'hot'

Jobs

'doctor' is to 'hospital' as 'teacher' is to 'school'

Animals

'cub' is to 'lion' as 'kitten' is to 'cat'

Transportation

'aeroplane' is to 'fly' as 'boat' is to 'sail'
