12. 585 pencils are shared equally among the students in 4A and 4B. There are 32 children in 4A and 33 children in 4B. How many pencils does each student get?

$$585 \div (32 + 33) = 9$$

Each student gets 9 pencils.

13. There are 468 lamp posts on the left side of a street and 432 on the right side. 18 painters are employed to re-paint all the lamp posts. How many lamp posts does each painter need to re-paint?

$$(468 + 432) \div 18 = 50$$

Each painter needs to re-paint 50 lamp posts.
